

## Inpatient Services

**Eligible** reimbursement must be for out-of-pocket expenses related to inpatient hospitalization with a mental health diagnosis. All services must be provided by a licensed mental health professional, primary care physician, or with written approval from a licensed mental health professional or primary care physician for medical procedures for related physical injuries, at a licensed inpatient facility.

**Ineligible** expenses include, but are not limited to:

- Partial hospitalization that is **not** related to the treatment of mental health, or for medical procedures for related physical injuries that are **not** approved by a licensed mental health professional or primary care physician in writing;
- Hospitalization for conditions **other than** mental health treatment, or for medical procedures for related physical injuries that are **not** approved by a licensed mental health professional or primary care physician in writing.

Requests previously submitted to and reimbursed by the former fund administrator are not eligible for reimbursement.

\*Services that are not expressly listed as ineligible may be submitted for consideration and are reviewed on a case-by-case basis. If you are not certain if the service you are receiving--or are interested in receiving--is eligible, please contact JND Legal Administration.

### Eligible Inpatient Hospitalization for Mental Health

<u>Service Code</u>	<u>Description</u>
99221 - 99223	New or established behavioral health patient, initial hospital inpatient care
99231 - 99233	Subsequent hospital care evaluation and management
99251 - 99255	Initial inpatient consultation, as part of inpatient behavioral health services

### Eligible Acute/Rehab Inpatient Hospitalization Facility for Mental Health

<b>0114</b>	Private Room and Board Psych
<b>0124</b>	Semi-Private Room and Board Psych
<b>0134</b>	Semi-Private Room and Board Psych 3 and 4 bed
<b>0144</b>	Deluxe Private Room and Board Psych
<b>0154</b>	Room and Board Ward Psych
<b>0204</b>	Intensive Care Unit Psych

Survivors with insurance will supply a copy of Explanation of Benefits (EOB) from all insurance companies that covered outpatient services, along with a completed reimbursement form.

Survivors who do not have insurance will supply a paid invoice or superbill from the mental health provider, along with a completed reimbursement form.
